### **Lorenzo Colombo wins Race 3 at Adria ahead of Job Van Uitert and Marcus Armstrong**

*The Rookie Trophy saw Lorandi take his third win from three starts on the weekend, ahead of Branquinho and Fittipaldi. Floersch won the Women's Trophy*

Adria (Rovigo) 7/5/2017 – Lorenzo Colombo driving for the Bhaitech team took out Race 3 of the Italian F4 Championship powered by Abarth, the race run under cloudy skies on a predominately dry circuit but with parts of the circuit still damp, particularly off the racing line. Starting from pole position, the Italian lost the lead to the Dutchman Job Van Uitert (Jenzer Motorsport) on the first corner, however he immediately ran wide at the next turn putting him back to second, a position he would hold until the chequered flag. He then withstood the challenge of the New Zealander Marcus Armstrong (Prema Power Team), who finished in third.

- ∞ Just off the podium finished the two BWT Mucke Motorsport drivers: the Germans Lirim Zendeli and Sophia Floersch, this latest win in the Women's Trophy was also her best result of the season. Sixth was the winner of Race 2, the Italian Leonardo Lorandi (Bhaitech) who tried relentlessly to pass Floersch for fifth place. The top ten was completed by the Indian Kush Maini (Jenzer Motorsport), the Guatemalan Ian Rodriguez (DRZ Benelli), the Brazilian Felipe Branquinho (DR Formula), the Italian Federico Malvestiti (Jenzer Motorsport).
- ∞ In the chase for the Rookie Trophy, behind the winner Lorandi, we saw the two Brazilians Branquinho, Fittipaldi (Prema Power Team), the Argentine Giorgio Carrara (Jenzer Motorsport) and the Swiss Mickael Grosso (Corbetta Competizioni).
- ∞ The next round of the Italian F4 Championship powered by Abarth will be held over the weekend of June 23-24-25, at Vallelunga.
