Rome, 15 February 2019 – Moving forward in what has become an extremely successful tradition in Formula 4 racing, Prema Powerteam continues to grow up in terms of the roster for the 2019 season and is delighted to welcome Alessandro Famularo on board for the full Italian F4 Championship Powered by Abarth.
